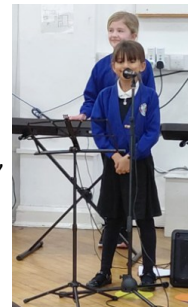
Annie Jr Performance

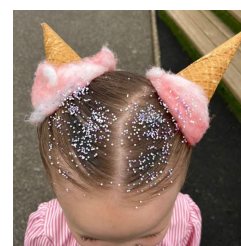
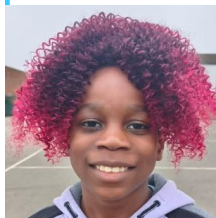


Comic Relief
