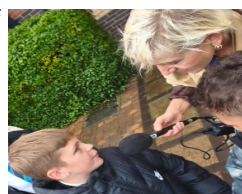


King Charles

Steering Group had the pleasure of meeting King Charles when he visited Grimsby. They received a royal wave as he drove past them, whilst heading to Horizon Youth



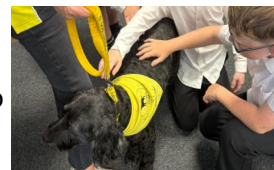

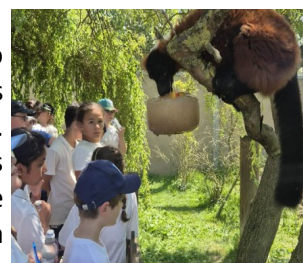
Nurse Visit

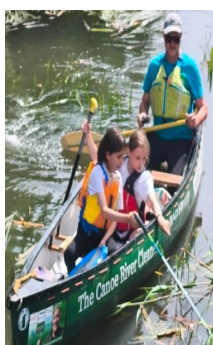
Lincoln Zoo
